Request for Special Temporary Authorization for Reduced Power Operation

NCE Station KBSX(FM), Boise, ID (Facility ID 28243)

Pursuant to Sections 73.1635 and 73.1560(d) of the FCC's Rules, the Idaho State Board of Education (Boise State University) (the "University"), licensee of noncommercial educational radio Station KBSX(FM), Boise, Idaho, respectfully requests Special Temporary Authorization ("STA") for a period of three (3) months for the station's reduced power operation due to technical issues.

Station KBSX began operating at 69% of its authorized power on or about June 8, 2015 due to equipment problems, specifically with respect to the station's transmitter. The University has made arrangements to obtain a new transmitter and currently hopes to receive and install it within the coming weeks in order to restore full power operation. Accordingly, the University seeks STA in order to continue the current reduced power operation until such time as it can complete the necessary equipment repairs.

A grant of reduced power STA will serve the public interest by allowing the University to maintain the station's current noncommercial educational radio operation and programming for listeners in the station's local community while it pursues the repairs needed to restore full power service. The University is a noncommercial educational licensee and it operates KBSX on a noncommercial educational basis. Moreover, the University qualifies as a governmental entity. The licensee is therefore exempt from FCC filing fee requirements, pursuant to Section 1.1116 of the Commission's Rules, and the facility is exempt from FCC regulatory fees, pursuant to Section 1.1162 of the Rules.
