

Protection of Table Mountain Radio Receiving Zone

The original applicant (Colorado Christian University, "CCU") advised the Radio Frequency Management Coordinator at Boulder, Colorado of the proposed change to this facility, and CCU provided that individual with a copy of that application. The KLDV transmitter site has been and is located 57.5 kM south of the Table Mountain Radio Receiving Zone. It is not expected that the proposed changes in the operation of KLDV will degrade the present ambient radio signal level in the protected zone. CCU agreed to work closely with personnel at Table Mountain to enable them to insure that the signals from KLDV at Table Mountain do not interfere with the work done there. EMF agrees to the same terms.

When the Commission originally granted the Construction Permit for a nearly identical facility (this proposal lowers the COR), a special operating condition or restriction was included, requiring appropriate cooperation with the Radio Frequency Management Office of the National Oceanographic and Atmospheric Administration's Environmental Research Laboratories in Boulder, Colorado (see FCC File Number BPED-20010601AGJ). EMF agrees to the same conditions.
