Community Information and Education Radio, Inc.
Moulton, Alabama

Community Information and Education Radio, Inc. (CI), an Alabama corporation, is organized with the purpose of operating a Low Power FM radio station under license from the Federal Communications Commission, to serve the community of Moulton, Alabama with locally-originated informational and educational programming. *organized 5/25/01 in Alabama*

Currently, Moulton, which is the county seat of Lawrence County, has no full-time, locally-originated broadcast programming, other than an automated daytime-only AM radio station. The only other local media outlet is a weekly newspaper. (CI is not affiliated with any other media outlet.) This not only limits locally-originated informational and educational program dissemination, but public health and safety information availability as well. Our area of Alabama is frequently affected by severe weather, and we are located less than 15 miles from a nuclear power plant. Lawrence County Emergency Management Agency has no 24-hour local broadcast outlet available to notify area residents. We are a mostly rural, low-to-moderate income area. This lack of local broadcast outlets also limits job-training opportunities for students interested in entering the media profession. Therefore, since the FCC's initiative is to bring educational/informational services to communities not locally served by broadcast media, we have formed this corporation to serve our community's needs.

Principals of CI are longtime residents of Moulton, Alabama, with experience in media (print and broadcast), as well as experience in community relations and educational programs. Initially, the three principals will conduct all activities. It is anticipated that multiple student interns (selected without regard to race, sex, religion or national origin) will be recruited to assist with all ongoing activities. As the situation permits, we hope to provide additional employment opportunities as well.

The following describes the various types of ongoing activities to be conducted by CI, to fulfill its 24/7 commitment to community information and education programming.

Dissemination of Community Information

- Board of Education meetings, school schedules, school events, weather-related or other school closings, school announcements related to policies/procedures/safety, etc.
- Local government information, City Council meetings, County Commission meetings, road work/closings, voter registration information, public services (Department of Health, Department of Human Resources, Extension Cooperative System, etc.), public hearings
- Community events (fairs, festivals, parades, ceremonies, civic initiatives, etc.)
- Church schedules, announcements, events
- Charitable organization information (events, fund-raisers, service availability, etc.)

Media Production and Media Operations Education -- student interns will be instructed in the following --

- Research and preparation of materials for educational broadcast
- News gathering and preparation for informational broadcast
- Operation and maintenance of broadcast equipment, hardware and software
- Compliance with FCC license requirements and operational regulations
- Community relations
