**Request for Increased Digital Power
Hybrid IBOC Digital Operation**

Dear Licensee:

This letter is in reference to the request filed May 2, 2018, by Capstar TX, LLC, as Debtor in Possession (Capstar), licensee of commercial FM Station WDVE(FM), Pittsburgh, PA.¹ Capstar requests authority to operate Station WDVE(FM) with increased digital effective radiated power (ERP) in excess of -20 dBc², pursuant to the Media Bureau's Order adopted January 27, 2010, in MM Docket No. 99-325.³

Our review indicates that the notification requirements of the Order have been satisfied, and that the proposed operation complies with the technical requirements of the Order.

Accordingly, the request IS HEREBY GRANTED. Station WDVE(FM) may operate with increased digital ERP and transmitter power output (TPO) as follows:

Analog ERP:	55 kilowatts (kW) (H&V) ⁴
Digital ERP:	1.8 kW (H&V)

Analog TPO: 23.5 kW
Digital TPO: 0.77 kW

As required by Section 73.1560(b) of the Commission's rules,⁵ Capstar must maintain WDVE(FM) analog and digital TPO values within 90 percent and 105 percent of the values shown above.

Capstar must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines specified in Section 1.1310 of the Commission's rules.⁶ It may be necessary for Capstar to reduce the power of the digital signal or cease hybrid digital operation if interference complaints are received. This authority may be modified or cancelled by the Commission without notice or right to hearing. This authority attaches to, and runs concurrently with, the main WDVE(FM) station license. Capstar must post a copy of this authority with the WDVE(FM) station license.
