Educational Objective and Advancement of Educational Program

The Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia by and on behalf of the University of Georgia (the “University of Georgia” or “UGA”), the proposed assignee of Station WNEG-TV, Toccoa, Georgia (the “Station”), plans to operate the Station on a noncommercial educational basis and plans to convert the Station license to noncommercial educational status by filing the appropriate license modification application. The Station will be used for the advancement of an educational program in accordance with Section 73.621 of the FCC rules.

UGA is part of the University System of Georgia. UGA is a comprehensive land-grant and sea-grant university. UGA is the state of Georgia’s oldest, most-comprehensive and most diversified institution of higher education. UGA was incorporated by an act of the state’s General Assembly in 1785. Its main campus enrollment presently includes more than 25,000 undergraduate and 8,000 graduate/professional students. UGA offers baccalaureate, master’s, doctoral, and professional degrees and shares with the other research institutions of the University System of Georgia a set of core characteristics, including: a statewide responsibility and commitment to excellence and academic achievements having national and international recognition; a commitment to excellence in a teaching/learning environment dedicated to serve a diverse and well-prepared student body, to promote high levels of student achievement, and to provide appropriate academic support services; and a commitment to excellence in research, scholarship, and creative endeavors that are focused on organized programs to create, maintain, and apply new knowledge and theories, that promote instructional quality and effectiveness, and that enhance institutionally relevant faculty qualifications.

UGA’s educational objective for the Station is to serve the public, university students and faculty, and to contribute to UGA’s public service goals. UGA plans to fulfill this objective by providing high-quality public television programs to the community of license and surrounding areas, including offerings that feature educational content, documentaries, public affairs programming, and lifestyle programming.

UGA will use the Station to advance an educational program. UGA plans to work with Georgia Public Broadcasting with regard to programming. The Station will also further UGA’s mission to serve as a production center for arts, information, and entertainment programming as outreach to Northeast Georgia. In addition, UGA plans to use the Station to continue to provide laboratory assets for UGA students and faculty, and to expand these opportunities. As circumstances permit, UGA may also add UGA-produced programs on a wide range of topics from research to the performing arts to public affairs. In addition, UGA will work to ensure that its noncommercial educational program offerings as broadcast over the Station, including instructional, performing arts, and/or public affairs programming, will be responsive to issues of concern to the Station’s community of license and surrounding areas.
