

RADIO-TELEVISION CROSS OWNERSHIP STATEMENT

Under the Radio-Television Cross Ownership Rule currently in effect, 47 C.F.R. § 73.3555(c) ("Section 73.3555(c)"), the Commission has authorized the Media Bureau to allow ownership of up to two television stations and six commercial radio stations, subject to compliance with the local radio ownership limits, if at least "20 independently owned voices would remain in the market" (the "20-Voice Test").¹ Also, under Section 73.3555(c), if a party could own two television stations and six commercial radio stations, it instead may own one television station and seven radio station, subject to compliance with the local radio ownership limits.

For purposes of the 20-Voice Test, the Commission has identified each of the following as an independent voice:

- any independently owned and operated full power television station within the DMA of the television station's community of license;
- any independently owned full power radio station (commercial or noncommercial) that is either located in or has a reportable Arbitron share in the radio metro market where each relevant broadcast station is located;
- any English-language newspaper published at least four days a week within the television station's DMA and that have a circulation exceeding 5 percent of the DMA's households; and
- one cable system, if the cable service is "generally available to households in the DMA."

The following one television station in the Salt Lake City, Utah DMA and seven radio stations in the Salt Lake City-Ogden-Provo, Utah Arbitron Radio Metro (the "Stations") are currently under common control, through ownership by subsidiaries of Clear Channel Communications ("CCC"):

This existing combination of one television station and seven radio stations is permitted in accordance with Section 73.3555(c), provided the combination also complies with the local radio ownership limits. This instant statement of compliance with Section 73.3555(c) is being provided in connection with an application for a construction permit for the minor modification of radio station KODJ(FM), Salt Lake City, Utah. Also being submitted with such minor modification application is a showing that this combination of seven radio stations complies with the local radio ownership limits.

The following count of relevant other media demonstrates that the combination of one television and seven radio stations in this DMA is permitted, as the 20 Voice Test is

met. Just counting independent broadcast voices, the Salt Lake City Market has at least 39 independent voices - almost twice the required 20 voices. Moreover, given that there are at least eight independently owned full power television stations, this is a market that supports common ownership of two television stations under the local television (duopoly) rule; thereby permitting the common ownership of one television and seven radio stations.

Conclusion

Since there are at least eight independent television voices and there are at least 20 independent media voices in this market, either two television stations and six radio stations or one television and seven radio stations can be commonly owned in this market, subject to compliance with the local radio ownership rules. As demonstrated in the local radio ownership analysis for this application, the proposal to modify KODJ(FM), Salt Lake City, Utah, complies with Section 73.3555(a), the local radio ownership rule. Consequently, this combination of one television and seven radio stations also complies with Section 73.3555(c).
