### REASONS FOR LATE FILING OF APPLICATION

In connection with a previous renewal of license application, the Commission sent the licensee of WASV-TV a postcard authorization form which indicated that the station's new license term was to expire on "08-01-93" (see attached). Hence, the licensee did not file a renewal of license application on the actual due date, which was August 1, 1991. Therefore, it is respectfully requested that the Commission accept for filing and process this renewal application.

Station WASV-TV has been off the air because of financial problems. The licensee, Video Marketing Network, Inc., has found a new investor, which in the event this application is granted will infuse capital into the station which will permit a resumption of broadcasting to serve the public interest in the Asheville area of western North Carolina.

Because the station has been off the air, no issues/programs lists were prepared for the period that the station was off the air. Upon a return to the air, these lists will be prepared and filed in the station's public file within 10 days of the end of each calendar quarter, in accordance with the Commission's rules.

A current ownership report for Video Marketing Network, Inc. will be filed under separate cover.
