

## DTV Consent Agreement

On October 18, 1999, KXAN, Inc. (owned by LIN Television Corporation), licensee of satellite station KXAM-TV, NTSC Channel 14, with paired DTV Channel 27, Llano, Texas (Facility ID 35909), filed a minor modification application for maximized digital facilities of KXAM-DT (BPCDT-19991018AAV). On June 7, 2001, Fox Television Stations, Inc., licensee of TV station KRIV, NTSC Channel 26, and of KRIV-DT, Channel 27, Houston, Texas (Facility ID 22204), filed an amendment to its modification application to maximize the digital facilities of KRIV-DT (BMPCDT-19980807KH, as amended). Because of the potential for certain mutual interference between the two co-channel digital proposals, the minor modification applications have been treated by the FCC as mutually exclusive, absent an agreement between the parties.


To facilitate grant of each of the party's application to maximize its DTV facilities and each party's ability to certify on FCC Form 381 its intent to operate with such maximized facilities post-DTV-transition, each of KXAN, Inc. and Fox Television Stations, Inc., has filed an amendment to its respective above-referenced minor modification application to reduce the level of interference between the proposed operations to levels the FCC Media Bureau staff has indicated will be acceptable. In addition, each of the parties agrees, as set forth below, to accept any remaining interference that may result from grant of both of the pending applications.

To facilitate grant of the pending KXAM-DT application, Fox Television Stations, Inc. hereby agrees to accept any interference that may be caused by operations of station KXAM-DT pursuant to the proposal in the above-referenced KXAM-DT minor change application, as amended on November 5, 2004.

To facilitate grant of the pending KRIV-DT application, KXAN, Inc. hereby agrees to accept any interference that may be caused by operations of station KRIV-DT pursuant to the proposal in the above-referenced KRIV-DT minor change application, as further amended on November 5, 2004.

This DTV Consent Agreement may be signed in counterparts.
