TECHNICAL STATEMENT

This technical statement was prepared on behalf of Central Florida Educational Foundation, Inc. ("CFEF"), licensee of FM translator station W212BF, Channel 212D, Leesburg, Florida. W212BF re-broadcasts the signal of station WPOZ, Channel 202C2, Union Park, Florida. The proposed translator is outside the protected service contour of WPOZ, but complies with §74.1231(b)(1)(I) of the rules (see Exhibit A). This proposal seeks to change the community of license of the translator from Leesburg, Florida to Tavares, Florida. No actual technical change is proposed.

The W212BF translator antenna system will remain unchanged and is located on an existing tower. As such, the Federal Aviation Administration was not apprised of this proposal. Further, the tower has been registered with the Commission and assigned Antenna Structure Registration Number 1030743. Attached as Exhibit B is a study demonstrating that the proposed translator will not cause interference to any full service station, nor will interference be delivered to or received from any existing FM translator station or LPFM application.¹ All remaining data and exhibits used to certify this application have been forwarded to the applicant and can be submitted to the Commission upon request.

1) There is a pending application for a new FM station on Channel 212A at Eustis, Florida, submitted by CSN International (BNPED-19991027AAB). Since this instant application for W212BF proposes no change to the technical facilities of the translator, the proposed Eustis application, which has not been cut-off, is not considered.
