Dear Counsel:

This is in reference to the request filed June 11, 2007, on behalf of Legacy Media - Memphis, LLC ("LMM"). LMM requests extension of the special temporary authority ("STA") granted on March 14, 2007, to former licensee Concord Media Group, Inc., for operation of Station KWAM with parameters at variance and/or reduced power while maintaining monitor points within licensed limits.¹ In support of the request, LMM states that repairs to its tuning equipment are underway but that delays in delivery of certain parts have prevented completion of the work.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.


Our review indicates that the licensee has been prevented from restoring licensed operation due to causes beyond its control and has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem. Thus, extension of STA is warranted.

¹ KWAM is licensed for operation on 990 kHz with 10 kilowatts daytime and 0.45 kilowatt nighttime, employing different directional antenna patterns daytime and nighttime (DA-2-U).

Accordingly, the request for STA IS HEREBY GRANTED. Station KWAM may operate with parameters at variance and/or reduced power while maintaining monitor points within licensed limits. It will be necessary to further reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received. LMM must notify the Commission when licensed operation is restored.² LMM must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. See 47 CFR § 1.1310.

This authority expires on **March 10, 2008**.
