TECHNICAL STATEMENT

This Technical Statement was prepared on behalf of Cumulus Licensing, LLC ("Cumulus"), licensee of FM translator W252BN, Channel 252D, Tallahassee, Florida. Cumulus has a construction permit to make minor changes in the W252BN facilities (BMPFT-20141014AVC). This instant application seeks a license to cover the outstanding permit. Exhibit A is a calculation of the transmitter power output for FM translator W252BN.

There are three special operating conditions/restrictions listed on the W252BN permit. The first condition states:

"The permittee/licensee in coordination with other users of the site must reduce power or cease operation as necessary to protect persons having access to the site, tower or antenna from radio frequency electromagnetic fields in excess of FCC guidelines."

Cumulus states that it will reduce the power of W252BN or cease operation, as necessary, to insure that persons having access to the tower will not be exposed to radio frequency electromagnetic fields in excess of the FCC's guidelines.

The second condition states:

"Prior to commencing program test operations, FM Translator or FM Booster permittee must have on file at the Commission, FCC Form 350, Application for an FM Translator or FM Booster Station License, pursuant to 47 C.F.R. Section 74.14."

This application satisfies that condition.

The third condition states:

*****NOTE TO PERMITTEE*****

Notwithstanding the grant of this construction permit or the expiration date specified herein, your station's license will automatically expire as a matter of law on April 10, 2015 if the station has not resumed broadcasting before that time. See Pub. Law No. 101-110 Stat. 56, Section 403(1) (1996). See also Public Notice, Expedited Processing of Application Filed By Silent Stations, DA 96-818 (May 22, 1996). Upon resumption of broadcasting, the licensee must notify the Commission. This notice will be in addition to an application for a license to cover this permit."

Cumulus is aware of this condition and will provide the proper notifications in addition to this application. Based on the foregoing, it is believed that Cumulus has complied with all conditions and can operate W252BN in accordance with Commission's rules.
