

Affidavit

I, Ronald J. Bruno, President of Bruno Goodworth Network, Inc., Licensee of Class A television station WMVH-CA, do swear, under penalty of perjury, that the following statements are true, correct, and complete, to the best of my knowledge and belief.

Applicant urgently needs to change tower location from its currently specified tower to a nearby tower for the following reasons:

The owner of the tower Applicant currently rents space on, Keymarket Communications ("Keymarket"), formerly used the tower for their AM radio station. Keymarket has since turned in the AM license and discontinued broadcasting. The only other tenant on the tower was a two way communications company that went bankrupt. As a result we are the only renters left on the tower. According to Keymarket our rent is lower than their operating expense of the tower. Keymarket has, therefore, decided to disassemble the tower and sell the land. We have until the end of this summer to move WKHU-CD off of Keymarket's tower.

WMVH-CA has a construction permit to move to digital channel 40. Channel 40 was formally used by Cornerstone Broadcasting (Cornerstone) for its full power analog station. Cornerstone moved to digital channel 50 but has not yet removed its channel 40 antenna and coax run from its tower in Wall, PA. That tower is only a few miles away from our existing tower in Charleroi, PA. Cornerstone has indicated its willingness to rent tower space, including our use of the existing channel 40 antenna and coax run. They have offered us favorable rental terms.
