INTRODUCTION & ENGINEERING STATEMENT

On Friday, October 17, 2008 at approximately 11:50am MST, the diesel power generator providing power for the KOAS main transmission system suffered a failure of a water pump and fan bearing assembly. There is no commercial power at the KOAS main site. The diesel generator is the only source of power. We have just been informed it will take 10 days to two weeks to obtain replacement parts from Germany, where the diesel engine was manufactured. The licensee of KOAS would like to remain on the air with its KOAS-FM1 Booster Station Facility as specified in BLFTB-20050331AWQ.

INTRODUCTION & ENGINEERING STATEMENT cont'd page two: KOAS(FM)

Therefore, the licensee of KOAS(FM), RBG Las Vegas Licenses, L.L.C., requests Special Temporary Authority to continue the operation of FM Booster Station KOAS-FM1 without the KOAS main transmission facility in operation for a period of 30 days. This will allow the station to provide service to the public and will allow enough time to obtain parts and repair the diesel power generator at the main KOAS(FM) site, which will restore the operation of the KOAS main transmission facility by November 20, 2008.
