

**Compliance with Canadian Spacing Requirements**

The facility contemplated herein is located within 320 kilometers of the border between the United States and Canada. Internationally, the proposed facility is considered to be class "B". Under the terms of the Working Arrangement for the Allotment and Assignment of FM Broadcasting Channels Under the Agreement Between the Government of Canada and the Government of the United States of America Relating to the FM Broadcasting Service, as amended in 1997 ("Agreement"), Class B facilities must be separated from other stations which are separated by 0, 200, 400, or 600 kHz, and those separated by 10.6 or 10.8 mHz as follows:
