Dear Mr. Langham:

This is in reference to the request filed November 20, 2013, on behalf of Capstar TX LLC. ("Capstar"). Capstar requests further extension of the special temporary authority ("STA") granted on March 7, 2007, to operate Station WTKS during nighttime hours with an emergency non-directional antenna and reduced power.¹ In support of the request, Capstar states that due to administrative delays in the grant of the CP, the local permit expired and the process to obtain a new building permit and contractor has begun. The public interest will be served by the extension of STA, allowing WTKS to continue to serve its community and time for the local authorities to address the replacement building permit application.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Our review indicates that the licensee has been prevented from restoring licensed operation due


¹ WTKS is licensed for operation on 1290 kHz using a 5 kW non-directional antenna daytime, and a 5 kW directional antenna at night.

to causes beyond its control; thus extension of STA is warranted.

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED. Station WTKS may continue to operate during nighttime hours with parameters at variance and/or reduced power while maintaining monitor points within licensed limits. Operation during nighttime hours with a temporary nondirectional antenna and reduced power not to exceed 1.25 kilowatts also is authorized, only as necessary to facilitate the repair work. It will be necessary to further reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received. Capstar must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commissions exposure guidelines. See 47 CFR § 1.1310.

This authority expires on **May 29, 2014**.
