Dear Licensee:

By letter dated March 29, 2011, the staff cancelled the license of station WRBJ-DT, Magee, Mississippi, licensed to Roberts Broadcasting Company of Jackson, MS, LLC ("Roberts"). The letter stated that while Roberts was granted a construction permit for its digital facility, it never filed an application to cover construction of the permit and the permit had expired.

Roberts filed a timely petition for reconsideration supported by the declaration under penalty of perjury of its Director of Operations. Roberts states that "On February 17, 2009, Roberts completed construction of its DTV facilities and commenced operations in conformance with the specifications contained in its construction permit." Roberts further states that on June 25, 2009, it prepared an FCC Form 302-DTV ("Application to Cover") and attempted to file the form electronically, but that "due to an error with the Bureau's electronic filing system, it appears that the Application was never properly filed." According to Roberts, the station is currently operating.

Based upon these circumstances, we will grant reconsideration, reinstate the license for station WRBJ-DT and direct Roberts to file a license to cover. While the station's records in the Media Bureau's CDBS database show that Roberts began preparing an electronic FCC Form 302-DTV for the station in June 2009, Roberts did not complete all of the sections or take the steps necessary to transmit the form for electronic filing. In view of the forgoing, the petition for reconsideration filed by Roberts Broadcasting Company of Jackson, MS, LLC IS HEREBY GRANTED and the license for station WRBJ-DT IS HEREBY REINSTATED. **Roberts is directed to file an application for a license to cover the construction of its digital facility no later than 10 days from the date of this letter.**
