Fisher Broadcasting Company (“FBC”) wholly owns FRRG. FBC is the sole member of Fisher Broadcasting - Seattle TV, L.L.C., Fisher Broadcasting - Seattle Radio, L.L.C., Fisher Broadcasting - Portland TV, L.L.C., Fisher Broadcasting - Oregon TV, L.L.C., Fisher Broadcasting - Washington TV, L.L.C., Fisher Broadcasting - Idaho TV, L.L.C., and Fisher Broadcasting - S.E. Idaho TV, L.L.C. The following paragraphs lists the primary broadcast stations licensed to these limited liability companies.

Fisher Broadcasting - Seattle TV, L.L.C. is the licensee of KOMO-TV, Seattle, Washington (FIN #21656).

Fisher Broadcasting - Seattle Radio, L.L.C. is the licensee of KOMO(AM), Seattle, Washington (FIN #21647), KVI(AM), Seattle, Washington (FIN #35853), and KPLZ-FM, Seattle, Washington (FIN #21663).

In addition, Fisher has a Joint Sales Agreement with KING-FM, Seattle, Washington (FIN #11755).

Fisher Broadcasting - Portland TV, L.L.C. is the licensee of KATU(TV), Portland, Oregon (FIN #21649).

Fisher Broadcasting - Oregon TV, L.L.C. is the licensee of KVAL-TV, Eugene, Oregon (FIN #49766) and KCBY-TV, Coos Bay, Oregon (FIN #49750).

Fisher Broadcasting - Washington TV, L.L.C. is the licensee of KIMA-TV, Yakima, Washington (FIN #56033), KEPR-TV, Pasco, Washington (FIN #56029), and KLEW-TV, Lewiston, Idaho (FIN #56032).

Fisher Broadcasting - Idaho TV, L.L.C. is the licensee of KBCI-TV, Boise, Idaho (FIN #49760).

Fisher Broadcasting - S.E. Idaho TV, L.L.C. is the licensee of KIDK(TV), Idaho Falls, Idaho (FIN #56028).

Fisher Broadcasting Company also owns 50% of South West Oregon Broadcasting Corporation, licensee of KPIC-TV, Roseburg, Oregon (FIN #61551).

FBC has received Commission consent to acquire KPOU-TV, La Grande, Oregon, but that transaction has not yet been consummated.

In addition to the primary station licenses shown above, FRRG is the licensee of several FM translators and other auxiliary stations. All are being transferred to affiliates of Cherry Creek Radio LLC pursuant to the Purchase and Sale Agreement in this matter.

Similarly, FBC affiliates listed above are licensees of a number of low power television stations, television translators and other auxiliary stations. Information concerning those facilities will be supplied upon request.

Finally, it should be noted that FBC is itself a wholly owned subsidiary of Fisher Communications, Inc. ("FSCI"), a publicly held company. Among the shareholders of FSCI are various entities associated with Mario Gabelli and GAMCO Investors, Inc. Taken in the aggregate, these interests may constitute a cognizable interest in FSCI. Affiliates of GAMCO Investors, Inc. and Mr. Gabelli own cognizable interests in a number of other broadcast stations. Fisher does not believe that information concerning the Gabelli holdings is required to be submitted as part of this FCC Form 314, but, upon request, information concerning the licensees and individual stations in which Gabelli affiliates own interests will be supplied to the Commission.
