Agreements for Sale of Station

The schedules to the Agreement have not been filed with the Commission or placed in the station's public inspection file because certain schedules may contain confidential business information and, in any event, DotCom Plus, LLC does not believe that such schedules contain information relevant to the Commission's consideration of this application. Such schedules will be provided to the Commission upon the Commission's request.

The Local Marketing Agreement (the "LMA") to be entered into by the parties does not provide the licensee with an unfettered right to terminate the LMA; however the licensee may terminate the LMA in the event of a breach by the broker.

The Non-Competition Agreement among DotCom Plus, LLC and Barry D. Wood, which will be executed and delivered upon consummation of the assignment of the license, and the form of which is included as an exhibit to the Asset Purchase Agreement, contains a covenant not to compete. The geographical scope of this covenant extends to any radio station broadcasting business that the seller conducts within the Mobile, Alabama Metro Area as defined by Arbitron Corp.
