TECHNICAL STATEMENT

This technical statement and attached exhibits were prepared on behalf of Maverick Media of Eau Claire License LLC ("Maverick"), licensee of WAXX, Channel 283C, Eau Claire, Wisconsin. Maverick herein proposes to modify its existing license for the WAXX main antenna system to reflect a change in the non-directional antenna with deletion of beam tilt. The tower that supported the WAXX antenna system was destroyed in March 2011 following a winter storm, and the station has been operating under Special Temporary Authority ("STA") with temporary facilities since that time. The tower has now been replaced, and a replacement WAXX antenna has been installed. This instant application seeks to modify the WAXX license to reflect the use of an alternate non-directional antenna pursuant to §73.1690(c)(1). Based on the age of the license, it was determined that the geographic coordinates for the tower as referenced in the Antenna Structure Registration ("ASR") are at variance for those listed on the present license when converted to NAD 1927. Therefore, this application also corrects the coordinates to bring them into agreement with the ASR.

The licensed WAXX coordinates are North Latitude 44° 39' 51" and West Longitude 90° 57' 41" (NAD 1927). The coordinates for Antenna Structure Registration Number 1033664 are North Latitude 44° 39' 50" and West Longitude 90° 57' 40" when converted to NAD 1927 and rounded. This is a one second change in longitude and latitude. This amount of correction can

be proposed through the filing of this instant license modification application. As indicated on Exhibit A, the one second correction does not create any spacing issues to any other station. WAXX remains fully compliant with §73.207 of the rules on Channel 283C at the corrected site. It is further noted that the center of radiation of the replacement WAXX antenna was placed 539.0 meters above ground to accommodate other tower attachments. This reflects an increase in height of 2.0 meters than the licensed value. As this variance is within the scope of §73.1690(c)(1), this data is also being provided as part of the license modification.

As there is no permit associated with this instant filing with no typical operating conditions to address, Maverick states that it will reduce the power of WAXX, or cease operation in coordination with other users of the tower, to protect persons having access to the site from radio frequency electromagnetic fields in excess of FCC guidelines. Based on the foregoing, it is believed that WAXX is in compliance with the Commission's rules.
