Request for Extension of Special Temporary Authorization FM Translator Station W232AM, Stroudsburg, PA (Facility ID 49448)

Northeastern Pennsylvania Educational Television Association (“NPETA”), licensee of FM translator Station W232AM, Stroudsburg, Pennsylvania, respectfully requests a six-month extension of its Special Temporary Authorization (“STA”) for operation of the station at a variance from its licensed parameters. The FCC granted the existing STA on June 12, 2012 in FCC File No. BSTA-20120611ABJ to allow W232AM to operate from a temporary site at a short distance from the licensed location, and the STA is currently due to expire on December 12, 2012.

As NPETA previously notified the Commission, the licensed transmitter site location for W232AM is located on a rooftop of a dormitory on the campus of East Stroudsburg University. Prior to the original STA filing, NPETA was advised that the building was scheduled for demolition. As a result, NPETA applied for the STA to relocate the W232AM transmitter site to the rooftop of another nearby campus building. As explained in the original STA request, the STA facilities are similar to the licensed facilities (same frequency, antenna and effective radiated power, from a site approximately 1600 feet from the licensed site, with a slight change in height - see exhibit 29).

Following the grant of the STA, NPETA has taken steps to move forward with modification of the W232AM license to reflect its new permanent operation. Specifically, a minor change in licensed facility application for W232AM was filed on November 19, 2012 in FCC File No. BPFT-20121119AMM, and is currently pending. Thus until such time as the construction permit application can be granted and licensed, NPETA seeks a continuation of STA to maintain authorization for the uninterrupted operation of the translator station. An STA extension grant will therefore serve the public interest by authorizing NPETA to continue its existing noncommercial educational broadcast radio service (W232AM rebroadcasts co-owned NCE radio station WVIA-FM, Scranton, Pennsylvania, Facility ID 49436) for the translator’s service area.

NPETA is a noncommercial educational broadcaster and operates W232AM on a noncommercial educational basis. The licensee is therefore exempt from filing fee requirements pursuant to Section 1.1116 of the Commission’s rules and exempt from regulatory fee requirements pursuant to Section 1.1162 of the Commission’s rules.
