On September 10, 2009 Hanford Youth educational Services was formed to serve the community of Hanford Ca by providing local youth and adult teaching service several times per week. HYES also provides teaching programs for youth and teens, orienting the program to meet the needs of local youth in the community.

Provide outreach programs to encourage members of HYS to get involved with meeting the needs of the community.

The Low Power FM (LPFM) Radio station that is being applied for is to be used to further the Educational program of HYS and to allow other community programs an avenue to serve the local community. HVES will allow Hanford Boys and Girls club, local crisis Pregnancy Clinic , the local Food Bank as well as other organizations airtime to help the community including but not limited to

- Local Community Events
- Notification of local school events
- School schedules (including school schedule delays and closures daily foggy day weather updates)
- Weather coverage and warnings for the local area
- Community oriented news

HYS pledges to run the LPFM station 24 hours a day utilizing a minimum of 12 hours a day for local programming

- Program Schedule
- Syndicated programming represents approximately 5 % of our programming schedule including News at the top of each hour
- Local News Monday-Friday 8 hrs per day on the half hour “Locally Originated” and produced daily from our Local Studios
- Daily Programs 5:30-10:00 am Morning talk and Local news and events, Youth and local events programs in the community aired 10:00 am – 3:00pm Monday – Friday, Drive time evening show with Local News weather Youth activities and sports airs 3:00pm-7:00pm Monday – Friday
- Locally cover High School sporting events as they happen

HYS pledges to maintain a publicly accessible main studio Located within the city of Hanford Ca. that has local program origination capability, is reachable by telephone, is staffed at least 20 hours per week between 7 a.m. and 10 p.m., and is located within 16.1 kilometers (10 miles) of the proposed site for the transmitting antenna .
