

Statement re Compliance with Multiple Ownership Rules

On December 14, 2005, the FCC gave its consent to the assignment of the licenses of KCIL (FM), Houma, Louisiana (Facility ID 25520), KJIN (AM), Houma, Louisiana (Facility ID 25521), KBZZ-FM, Morgan City, Louisiana (Facility ID 67677) and KXOR-FM, Thibodaux, Louisiana (the "Stations"), from Guaranty Broadcasting Company of Houma, LLC to Sunburst Media-Louisiana, LLC ("Licensee"). See Application File Nos. BALH-20051031AEP, BAL-20051031AEQ, BALH-20051031AER and BALH-20051031AES. On June 28, 2006, the FCC gave its consent to the transfer of control of Sunburst Media-Louisiana, LLC from Don L. Turner to John Borders (the "Transferors"). See Application File Nos. BTRCH-20060503AAQ, BTC-20060503AAR, BTRCH-20060503AAS and BTCH-20060503AAT. Both the consents to assign and for transfer of control were consummated on July 20, 2006.

In connection with the above-referenced assignment and transfer of control applications, the Licensee/Transferors submitted a Multiple Ownership Compliance Study, hereby incorporated by reference, establishing that the city grade contours of the Stations comprised a single non-Metro radio market comprised of 29 radio services, including those of the four Stations, and that, therefore, the assignment and transfer of control transactions complied with Section 73.3555 (a) (1) (iii) of the Rules (which provides that in a radio market with between 15-29 full-power, commercial and noncommercial radio stations a person or entity may have a cognizable interest in not more than 6 commercial radio stations, of which no more than 4 may be in the same market).

The Transferees do not have any cognizable ownership interests in radio broadcast stations whose city grade contours overlap those of the Stations; accordingly, the instant application complies with Section 73.3555 (a) (1) (iii) of the Rules.
