Community Public Radio, Inc. (CPR) Permittee of station WIVL in Patterson, Georgia, desires to change the city of license to Athens, Georgia. The applicant will comply with the requirements of Section 307(b) fair distribution guidelines. The applicant is proposing technical changes to better serve Athens, Georgia. Patterson will continue to receive the same coverage as it currently does by WIVL. No white or gray areas will be created by the community of license change¹.

- Athens, GA, has seven licensed stations.
- The number of stations providing protected service to the proposed community of license is no fewer than 17.
- Currently, Patterson, GA has one licensed station (WIVL).
- Patterson will continue to receive protected service by no fewer than 20 stations. This exceeds the five station threshold required to show that a community is "well-served".
- The most recent Census of Athens shows 100,266 People.
- Athens is already a community for license as several full power stations are licensed to Athens.

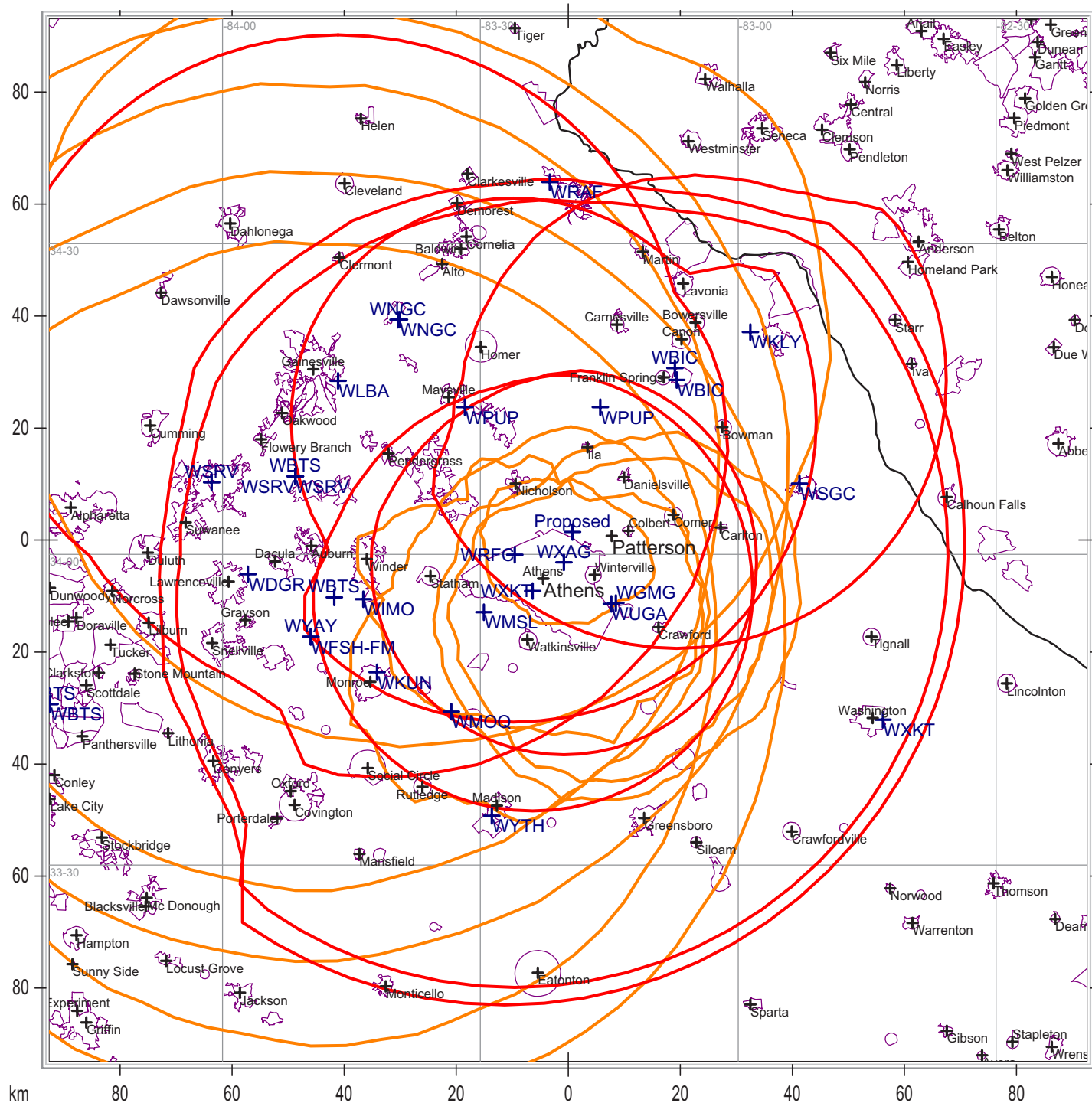
A map has been included, as Figure 1, that shows the stations that cover Patterson, GA. A list of stations that will continue to cover Patterson with a protected contour follows:

¹ The FM allotment priorities are: (1) First full-time aural service; (2) Second full-time aural service; (3) First local service; and (4) Other public interest matters.
