Dear Mr. Lampl:

This is in reference to the request filed on March 26, 2018. FTR requests a final extension of the STA granted on July 10, 1998, to continue operating from an alternate site to allow time to complete all remaining work at the new permanent transmitter site facility.<sup>1</sup> In support of the request, we noted that FTR plans to complete the new facility very shortly.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA is GRANTED, and FTR may continue to operate the station using the following facilities:

Frequency	1220 KHz
Hours of operation	Daytime only
Operating power	0.15 kW


