Dear Mr. White:

This is in response to your letter dated May 6, 2013.

In 2012, the Federal Communications Commission adopted rules requiring full power and Class A television broadcast stations to post most of their public inspection files online in a central, Commission-hosted database. Although stations have been required to upload new public file documents to the online database since the launch of the online file requirement last August, the Commission gave stations six months to upload documents that were already in their public inspection file when the new rule went into effect.¹

Thus, by February 2, 2013, all public file documents should have been uploaded to the online database. Your failure to comply with this deadline means your station is already in violation of the Commission's public file rule.² Your lack of awareness of the rule does not excuse the violation, as licensees are expected to know and comply with the Commission's rules.³

Further, you state that: "WWEO does have an up-to-date Public File available in our office during regular business hours. However, we were unaware of the requirement(s) for filing said documents online due to not receiving the letter in question." However, you have not clarified whether that public file contains the required issues-programs lists, which were required to be uploaded to the online public file by February 2, 2013.

The letter dated March 12, 2013 was sent to the address on file for the Station in CDBS, and your letter makes clear that you are able to access the correspondence folder on CDBS (and update the address on record). Nonetheless, as a courtesy, we are enclosing a copy of our March 12, 2013 letter with this correspondence.

We reiterate our request that you address these deficiencies by May 24, 2013. Failure to provide the information requested in the letter by that date will result in appropriate action, which may include a change of the station's status from Class A television to low power television status or a proposed forfeiture for the violations.
