ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS

The proposed construction will not have a significant environmental impact. The proposed antenna is to be mounted on an existing tower replacing a nearly identical antenna. Calculations of RF Radiation levels have been performed in accordance with OST Bulletin No. 65, Edition 97.1, dated August 1997, for all radiation sources on the tower. The total exposure levels at any accessible point in the vicinity of the tower, other than on the tower, are well below the permissible exposure level for the general public.

Policies have been adopted by Ramar Communications II, Ltd. to reduce power and/or shut down transmitters as necessary in order to avoid exposing workers on the tower to excessive RF radiation .
