Dear Secretary Dortch,

In August of 2015, the Mutual Musicians Foundation of Kansas City, MO was granted a construction license: BNPL 20131114ARG, Application ID: 1668403.

Due to a lawsuit initiated by myself against current board members for fiduciary misconduct, sexual harassment and many other allegations, I am currently requesting that this construction license be put in Tolling as our construction permit expires January 2018 but the trial is not until April 18, 2018

Hopelessly deadlocked in the "status quo" orders of the judge, neither party can move forward with the construction license until a verdict is rendered.

I have included information from my attorney to the radio advocate organization Prometheus Radio which has been instrumental in assisting us with the building of the station and the judge's orders denying the defendants access to the funding raised for the station's antenna and transmitter.

I come to you today with this request and pray for an expedient decision of the FCC to save this very important license for a community so sorely in need of a voice of truth and honesty.


RE: *Anita Dixon and Mutual Musicians Foundation v. James Hathaway, et al.*

Dear Mr. Bame:

I am contacting you again on behalf of Anita Dixon, who I represent in the ongoing litigation against others associated with the Mutual Musicians Foundation. As I advised via email on May 18, 2017, on March 30, 2017 the Judge in this case entered his orders and expressed his intention that the status quo of the parties be maintained while litigation is pending. As a result of the judge's entry of this order, the parties are presently deadlocked in the "status quo," and the practical outcome is that no party has the ability to move forward with construction of the proposed radio station and antenna at this time.

It is our position that anyone other than Anita Dixon or her authorized agent for that matter, purporting to act on behalf of the MMF in regard to the radio station and antenna, would be acting out of bounds of the status quo as ordered by the Judge. Please continue to direct all communication regarding these matters to Anita Dixon.


**ORDER DENYING MOTION TO RELEASE FUNDS**
