

Report on Radiofrequency Measurements for
Station KAVB, Hawthorne, Nevada (FCC Facility ID 164094)

The undersigned hereby provides the FCC with the results of radiofrequency electronic (RF) field strength measurements that were taken throughout the Station transmitter site area. I took the measurements on October 15, 2008 and determined that the FCC's guidelines for human exposure to RF fields are not exceeded. Maximum reading at 2 meters above ground level at the base of the transmitting tower was 50 watts, well below the allowable limit of 200 watts.

Measurements were made with an Anritzu field strength and spectrum analyzer.

I am currently the Chief Operating Engineer for KQMC FM in Hawthorne, Nevada and have worked in broadcasting since 1963.
