TECHNICAL STATEMENT

This Technical Statement and attached exhibits were prepared on behalf of Glory Communications, Inc. ("GCI"), licensee of WLJI, Channel 252A, Summerton, South Carolina. GCI currently has an outstanding construction permit for WLJI, BPH-200403008ADV. GCI herein proposes to make minor changes in the permit by relocating the tower a slight distance, decreasing the antenna height above average terrain and antenna height above mean sea level and increasing the effective radiated power of the station.

During local zoning clearance, GCI was informed that no tower greater in height than 137.2 meters (450 feet) above ground level would be approved. In addition, the coordinates of the facility are changed slightly to allow relocation of the guy anchors of the tower. GCI is proposing to locate the antenna system for WLJI on a new tower. As such, the Federal Aviation Administration ("FAA") has been appraised of this proposal. Once the FAA has issued its Determination of No Hazard, the tower will be registered with the FCC.

Using the Commission's contour propagation curves, the 70 dBu contour of the proposed WLJI does not encompass Summerton. However, using an alternate propagation model, the community of Summerton does receive the requisite city grade coverage. See Exhibit A for details. All other necessary documentation used to certify the technical portion of FCC Form 301 has been forwarded to the GCI and is available to the Commission upon request.
