

Dear Greg:

I am writing on behalf of K-W TV, Inc., licensee of WCTX(TV), Ch. 59 (DTV Ch. 6), New Haven, Connecticut (the "Station"). The FCC's staff recently approved the Form 314 application (BALCT-20010917AAD) for consent to assign the licenses of the Station from K-W TV, Inc. to WTNH Broadcasting, Inc., a wholly-owned subsidiary of LIN Television Corporation (collectively, "WTNH"). This transaction has not yet closed pending final resolution of a Petition for Reconsideration of the license assignment grant filed by Meredith Corporation.

You have advised me that, contingent on the consummation of the WCTX transaction, WTNH and Connecticut Public Broadcasting, Inc., licensee of noncommercial educational TV station WEDY-TV, Ch. 65 (DTV Ch. 39), New Haven, Connecticut, have agreed to seek FCC consent to swap the WCTX and WEDY-TV digital construction permits. Pursuant to Section 73.3517(a) of the Rules, K-W TV, Inc. hereby grants to WTNH, as Assignee of WCTX, permission to file an application to modify the digital construction permit for the Station, contingent on final approval and consummation of the WCTX license assignment.
