Dear Mr. Jenkins:


As requested, this is a letter from station KSBY TV concurring with the application by Educational Media Foundation for proposed station KGLV Class B FM operation on channel 208B (89.5 Mhz) in Shafter, CA. This letter is written for the purpose of satisfying the Federal Communications Commission in connection with Section 73.525 and 74.1205 of the Rules concerning potential interference created by educational FM stations to the converge area of Channel 6 television stations. It should be understood that our concurrence is conditional upon the following:

1. We concur only with that which is specified in your application to the Federal Communications Commission as follows: relocation of the KGLV antenna to a new tower at coordinates 35-36-53 N, 119-28-16 W, with an increase in power to 50kw.
2. Any future modifications that require a construction permit from the FCC will require a new letter from us.
3. KSBY TV shall be notified two days in advance of the start of equipment tests.
4. Programming shall not be broadcast over the new facility until all reasonable complaints of interference to channel 6 which are triggered as a result of the equipment tests have been resolved to the satisfaction of KSBY TV.
5. Educational Media Foundation and KGLV FM agree to cooperate in resolving any channel 6 interference complaints which occur after the commencement of regular programming from the new location and power. This includes reasonable requests for on-off tests if such tests should be deemed necessary by KSBY TV.
6. It is understood that Educational Media Foundation and KGLV FM will comply with all pertinent FCC Rules regarding the alleviation of any interference which may be caused by its new facilities.
7. This letter is not valid until signed by representatives of both parties and a copy returned to KSBY TV.
