Dear Mr. Lipp:

This is in reference to the request filed on January 13, 2014. Cumulus requests further extension of the STA originally granted on March 5, 2010, to operate with reduced daytime power using a 6 kW transmitter.¹ In support of the request, Cumulus states that it is close to making a decision regarding all problems.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.


We noted that Cumulus did not supply any new information as to why steps were not taken in the past six months to restore licensed operations (such as installing a new transmitter or filing an FCC Form 301 application). Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED for a reduced period of time. Station KFAY may continue to operate with reduced daytime power as previously granted. It will be necessary to further reduce power or

cease operation if complaints of interference are received. Cumulus must notify the Commission when licensed operation is restored.² Cumulus must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310.

This authority expires on **May 20, 2014**. Failure to resume licensed operations (or take steps towards resumption) may result in a cancellation of this STA.
