
Dear Madame Secretary:

Pursuant to Section 73.3517(a) of the Commission's Rules, Sea-Comm, Inc. ("Sea-Comm"), as the licensee of the above-referenced radio station (the "Station"), hereby grants permission to Educational Media Foundation ("EMF"), the proposed assignee of the license for the Station in File No. BALH-20070108ABA, to file an FCC Form 302-FM application with the Commission in order to request a waiver of the Commission's main studio rule and to convert the Station's licensed status from commercial to noncommercial, educational, contingent upon the consummation of the assignment of the license for the Station from Sea-Comm to EMF. The said Form 302-FM application will be filed at EMF's expense prior to the closing. If the consummation of the assignment of the license for the Station from Sea-Comm to EMF does not occur, EMF will request that the FCC dismiss the FCC Form 302-FM application as moot and return the Station's licensed status to its current specifications.
