Dear Family Life:

This is in reference to the request filed February 10, 2014 on behalf of Family Life Educational Foundation ("Family Life"). Family Life explains that KKML continues to operate at reduced power due to interference caused to the Nexus Internet service. Family Life has been working with Nexus and has determined that the current power level would not cause interference. Family Life is looking at solutions such as moving the FM antenna higher on the tower, as the tower owner has secured the necessary permits for such work and is arranging for a tower crew. In the meantime, Family Life requests an extension of the STA granted February 11, 2014 for continued operation at reduced power, which will enable KKML to continue service to its community of license.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:


- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Our review indicates that the licensee is working on a permanent solution, but additional time is required to resolve the issues inhibiting implementation of the construction permit. Thus, extension of STA is warranted.

Accordingly, the request for STA extension IS HEREBY GRANTED. Station KKML may continue to operate with reduced power. Family Life must notify the Commission when licensed operation is restored. Family Life must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from radiofrequency exposure in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310.

This authority expires on **February 15, 2015**.
