This Technical Exhibit supports the Petition for Reconsideration by Miller Communications, Inc. ("Miller"), proponent for a new FM fill-in translator station in Sumter, South Carolina. The proposed translator station will operate on Channel 227D at 0.25 kilowatt to re-broadcast the WIBZ, Wedgefield, South Carolina, signal in Sumter.

In a letter dated March 3, 2004, the Commission dismissed the application citing interference delivered to the authorized facilities of WSIM, 229A, Bishopville, South Carolina. Miller is also the licensee of WSIM. We note that in MM Docket #02-197 the Commission changed the WSIM city of license from Bishopville to Lamar, South Carolina. In February 2003 Miller filed an application to relocate WSIM under the above docket to a new location to serve Lamar. This application was granted on November 5, 2003. WSIM commenced operation from the new location on March 17, 2004, and filed an application for station license to cover the newly relocated operation (BLH-20040319AIG). The relocated facility of WSIM does not receive interference from the facility specified in the translator application.

By the above we respectfully request reconsideration and reinstatement of BNPFT-20030828AGI as an acceptable application.
