

Amendment to Assignment of License Application

Dear Ms. Dortch:

At the request of the Commission's staff, Evening Post Publishing Company hereby amends the assignee's portion of the above-referenced application to disclose the following information concerning the two non-competition agreements that the parties intend to enter at the closing of the proposed transaction.

Under the first non-competition agreement, New Vision Group, LLC, NVG Santa Barbara, Inc., NVG-Santa Barbara II, Inc., and any entity directly or indirectly controlling, controlled by or under common control with them, agree not to compete with KSBY(TV) for a period of two years from the closing. Under the second non-compete agreement, Jason Elkin, who is the Chief Executive Officer of New Vision Group, LLC, agrees not to compete with KSBY(TV) for a period of two years from the closing. Both agreements would apply only within an area that (1) receives an analog signal of Grade B or better from KSBY(TV) as of the closing or (2) may lawfully receive an analog signal of KSBY(TV) via any cable television system, satellite provider, or any other provider of video entertainment or information within the Santa Barbara-Santa Maria-San Luis Obispo DMA.
