**CHANGES IN INTEREST**

Pursuant to File No. BALH-20001109AAS, the Commission approved the assignment of license of Radio Station KXOL-FM, Los Angeles, California from the International Church of the Four Square Gospel to Spanish Broadcasting System, Inc. (Delaware) on January 11, 2001.
