TECHNICAL STATEMENT

This Technical Statement and attached exhibits were prepared on behalf of Legend Communications of Wyoming, LLC (“Legend”), permittee of KZZS, Channel 252C2, Thermopolis, Wyoming. In MM Docket #00-159, the community of license of KZZS was changed to Story, Wyoming, and the class of the station upgraded to Channel 252C1. This instant modification proposes to implement the change in community of license to Story. However, a Class A facility is proposed for Story in this instant application as a one-step downgrade.¹

Since KZZS proposes to co-locate on an existing tower, the Federal Aviation Administration (“FAA”) has not been apprised of this proposal. It is noted that Legend is proposing to install the KZZS antenna on a short tower on which another FM station will be co-located. As such, the RFR worksheets associated with FCC Form 301 could not be used to verify that this proposal meets the Commission’s Radio Frequency Radiation exposure limits. Therefore, attached as Exhibit A is a study demonstrating that this facility, in conjunction with the other FM station, is in compliance with the Commission’s Radio Frequency Radiation limits. All exhibits called for on FCC Form 301, Section III-B, are attached hereto. All other exhibits used to certify the application have been forwarded to Legend and are available for submission to the Commission upon request.

1) This application proposes an interim/independent facility than that proposed in BMPH-20020206AAV, which is for Channel 252C1 at Story. However, due to winter construction issues in Wyoming, and the imminent deadline for construction on the facility to avoid cancellation of the permit, this instant application is being submitted.
