Dear Counsel:

This is in reference to the request filed November 17, 2006, on behalf of Win Radio Broadcasting Corporation ("WRB"). WRB requests extension of the special temporary authority ("STA") granted on May 19, 2006, for operation of Station WCTN with temporary facilities.<sup>1</sup> In support of the request, WRB states that it is in the process of completing construction of modified WCTN facilities authorized by Construction Permit BP-20050323AAW. WRB states that both of the towers authorized by the permit and a new transmitter building have been constructed, and that it is waiting for the electric utility to install power lines to the site.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Our review indicates that the licensee has made progress toward restoration of licensed operation, but additional time is required for completing the work. Thus, extension of STA is warranted.

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED. Station WCTN may continue to operate with a temporary nondirectional antenna and reduced power not to exceed 0.625 kilowatt daytime and 0.012 kilowatt nighttime, as necessary to facilitate the construction work.

<sup>1</sup> WCTN is licensed for operation on 950 kHz with 2.5 kilowatts daytime and 0.047 kilowatt nighttime, employing different directional antenna patterns daytime and nighttime (DA-2-U). Construction Permit BP-20050323AAW authorizes modification of the directional antenna system and operation with 2.5 kilowatts daytime and 0.039 kilowatt nighttime.

Following completion of construction, WCTN may operate with the substantially adjusted daytime and nighttime directional antenna patterns authorized by the permit. It will be necessary to further reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received. WRB must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310.

This authority expires on **February 27, 2008**.
