

CONTINGENT APPLICATIONS NARRATIVE

The present application is one of two related, simultaneously filed applications submitted for processing under Section 73.3517 of the Commission's Rules (the contingent application rule). The two applications request minor modifications to the facilities of radio Stations WGRL, Fishers, Indiana and WQKC, Seymour, Indiana. Specifically, WGRL requests a change in transmitter location and effective radiated power, and WQKC requests 73.215 processing with a directional antenna from its current site. The application process, and the subsequent construction and implementation, is being coordinated by Susquehanna Radio Corp., parent of both licensees.

The WGRL modification application is filed by the licensee, INDY LICO, Inc. The WQKC modification application is filed by S.C.I. Broadcasting, Inc. INDY LICO, Inc. and S.C.I. Broadcasting, Inc. are subsidiary corporations of Susquehanna Radio Corp. As such, both licensees request that the Commission process the two modification applications together, and take action on both applications simultaneously.

Accordingly, these applications comply with the contingent application rule which requires the submission of an agreement to make coordinated facility modifications. See 47 C.F.R. § 73.3517(e). In this case, no agreement is necessary among affiliated companies. Because of this relationship, the Commission can be assured that both parties have the same incentive to ensure that the modifications to the respective facilities will be performed.
