

**MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT TO FILE CONTINGENT APPLICATIONS**


Pikes Peak Community College, licensee of Station K228EY, Pueblo, Colorado (Facility ID No. 85384) and Cheyenne Mountain Public Broadcast House, Inc., licensee of Station K228EM, Colorado Springs, Colorado (Facility ID No. 88551) (collectively, the "Parties") hereby evince their agreement that each will file, simultaneously, with the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC"), contingent FCC Form 349 Applications.


In order to accommodate the minor change application filed by Station K228EM, involving an increase in effective radiated power and a change in its current directional antenna to a non-directional antenna, the K228EY minor change application will substitute Channel 227 in lieu of its licensed Channel 228. K228EY will remain at its current transmitter site and, other than its change to a first adjacent channel, will operate with the same facilities specified in its station license.

A copy of this Memorandum of Agreement will serve as an attachment to each of the Parties' Applications. The Parties request that the FCC staff simultaneously process and grant their Contingent Applications.
