**TECHNICAL STATEMENT**

This technical statement was prepared on behalf of Inspiration Time, Inc. ("ITP"), an applicant seeking authority to construct a new FM translator station to re-broadcast the signal of station WCTL, Channel 292A, Union City, Pennsylvania. The proposed translator is inside the protected service contour of WCTL. As such, this is considered a fill-in translator.

The proposed new FM translator antenna system will be mounted on an existing tower. As such, the Federal Aviation Administration was not apprised of this proposal. Further, the tower has been registered with the Commission and assigned Antenna Structure Registration number 1037807. Attached as Exhibit A is a map which shows the proposed translator's 60 dBu contour is wholly contained within the 60 dBu contour of WCTL. Further, attached as Exhibit B is a study demonstrating that the proposed translator will not cause interference to any full service station, nor will interference be delivered to or received from any existing FM translator station or LPFM application. Using the radio frequency radiation worksheets associated with FCC Form 349, it has been determined that this proposal is in compliance with the Commission's radio frequency radiation guidelines.
