TECHNICAL STATEMENT

This Technical Statement and attached exhibits were prepared on behalf of Cross Country Communications, LLC ("CCC"), permittee of WLKW-FM, Channel 237A, Celoron, New York (BNPH-20110630ADZ). CCC proposes changes to implement an auxiliary facility for WLKW-FM to be used when the main antenna is out of service for repairs or maintenance. The proposed auxiliary system will operate with an effective radiated power of 0.43 kilowatt.

CCC is proposing to install the antenna system for the WLKW-FM auxiliary facility on an existing short tower located atop a building that does not require registration. As such, the FAA has not been notified of this proposal.

Since this proposal is for an auxiliary antenna system, no allocation review, community coverage issues, main studio location, or interference issues are considered in this instant application. Attached as Exhibit A is a map that shows the proposed auxiliary facility's 60 dBu contour will not extend beyond that of the proposed new FM's main 60 dBu contour.

There is one non-directional AM station within 0.8 kilometer of this proposal. WKSJ operates on 1340 kHz and is located 0.5 kilometer from this proposal. The WLKW-FM auxiliary antenna will be mounted on an existing tower atop an existing building. Neither the tower atop

the building nor the building itself have any de-tuning apparatus with respect to the AM station. It is, therefore, requested that this proposal not be conditioned to require any pre- or post-construction measurements on station WKSN.

Since this facility will be co-located with another FM facility, the use of the worksheets to establish compliance with radio frequency radiation exposure compliance is not possible. Exhibit B demonstrates that this facility will be in compliance. All of the remaining exhibits used to certify the information on Form 301 have been forwarded to CCC and are available for submission to the Commission on request.
