

### Character Explanation

Although the following does not affect the applicant's ability to certify 'yes' to this question, the applicant notes out of an abundance of caution: the Media Bureau sent a letter to Fox Television Stations, Inc. (FTS), indicating that the Commission was investigating allegations raised by third parties concerning the accuracy, completeness and truthfulness of certain representations made by FTS in connection with the 2007 license renewal application for WWOR-TV, Secaucus, NJ. See DA-11-314. FTS denied the third party allegations. On August 8, 2014, the Media Bureau issued a Memorandum Opinion and Order as part of MB Docket No. 07-260 in which it granted WWOR-TV's license renewal application and indicated that the allegations referenced above do not warrant further review. An application for review was filed by such third parties and was opposed by FTS. The application for review remains pending.

Citizens for Responsibility and Ethics in Washington (CREW) filed a petition to deny (Petition) against three license renewal applications for other stations licensed to FTS. A handful of informal objections also were filed, which mimicked the allegations in the CREW Petition. The Crew Petition raised allegations of unadjudicated, non-FCC misconduct in connection with a former separate, unrelated foreign subsidiary of the ultimate parent company of FTS. The CREW Petition and informal objections were denied by the Media Bureau in May 2013 and two of the three challenged license renewal applications have since been granted. Also, since then, there was an adjudication of misconduct in a United Kingdom court on June 24, 2014 against a former UK employee of the foreign company that previously was a subsidiary of FTS' ultimate parent. There has been no adjudication of the misconduct, however, against any parent or sibling company of FTS, nor has there been any adjudication of misconduct against any officers, directors or attributable owners of FTS. Accordingly, the allegations raised in the CREW Petition do not constitute an impediment to grant of this application.
