Dear Ms. Dortch:

The above-referenced file number refers to a request by Southern TV Corporation for authority for Station W32BJ to remain silent, beginning December 12, 2014. The CDBS and LMS databases were not changed to show the station as silent, so the licensee is unable to open and file a notice of resumption of operation in LMS and must provide notice by a paper filing.

I have been informed by the President of the licensee that W32BJ resumed operation at 6:30 p.m. on December 12, 2015. Attached is a photograph sent to me of a receiver displaying the signal, along with a newspaper dated December 12.

I have also been advised that operation resumed with the licensed facilities authorized under File No. BLTT-19970401JB. However, the final tube failed when the transmitter was activated, with the result that, although the licensed antenna is being used, the transmitter output



is only approximately 4 watts. The transmitter is old enough that finding a replacement tube will be difficult. If full power operation cannot be restored within 10 days, a notice of operation at reduced power will be required.
