On February 26, 2016, the licensee as addressed above was sent a 30 day deficiency letter for the following issue:

LANDMOBILE SPACING VIOLATIONS FOUND: Contour overlap of HOUSTON TX  
Channel 17

You were given 30 days from the date of that letter to file an electronic amendment to resolve the above deficiency, or we will dismiss your application.

On March 2, 2016, you filed an amendment lowering you ERP from 9 kW to 2 kW for the purpose of resolving the above interference issue. However, the current interference study at the 2 kw power level reveals that the Landmobile Spacing Violation still exist and was not resolved; therefore, the above referenced proposal LMS-0000007971 IS  
HEREBY DISMISSED.
