Dear Applicant:

On March 4, 2016, the licensee as addressed above was sent a 30 day deficiency letter outlining the following interference issue:

The proposal is predicted to cause interference to the following facilities:

1. W49EM-D – Lima, OH. – BNPDTL-20100609AFL at 51%

You were given 30 days from the date of that letter to file an amendment electronically to resolve the above deficiency, or we will dismiss your application.

We received the amendment filed March 14, 2016. The engineering analysis of the amended engineering specification shows that your proposal still is predicted to cause interference to W49EM-D – Lima, OH. – BNPDTL-20100609AFL at 12%.

Since the amended engineering specification did not resolve the above interference to or below the allowable 2.0% for a Low Power Station; the above referenced proposal LMS-0000008090 IS HEREBY DISMISSED.
