

Legal Certifications – Character Issues

THE APPLICANT BELIEVES THAT THIS QUESTION IS PROPERLY ANSWERED IN THE AFFIRMATIVE. HOWEVER, OUT OF AN ABUNDANCE OF CAUTION, IT IS NOTED THAT IN THE MATTER OF EDWIN L. EDWARDS, SR. ET AL, 16 FCC RCD 22236 (2001), SINCLAIR WAS FOUND QUALIFIED TO BE A COMMISSION LICENSEE AND THE ASSIGNMENT APPLICATIONS WERE GRANTED. IN THAT MATTER, THE COMMISSION ISSUED A FORFEITURE WHICH HAS BEEN PAID. ADDITIONALLY, VARIOUS PARTIES HAVE FILED COMPLAINTS AND OTHER OBJECTIONS AGAINST SINCLAIR AND STATIONS LICENSED TO SINCLAIR'S SUBSIDIARIES. AS A RESULT OF THESE FILINGS, A NUMBER OF SINCLAIR'S APPLICATIONS REMAIN PENDING BEFORE THE COMMISSION.
