NCE Station WVIA-TV, Scranton, PA (Facility ID 47929)

On behalf of Northeastern Pennsylvania Educational Television Association (“NPETA”), licensee of noncommercial educational television Station WVIA-TV, Scranton, Pennsylvania, we hereby inform the Commission that WVIA-TV has resumed full power operation following a brief period of reduced power operation.

By online filing on June 9, 2016 in FCC File No. 0000011132, NPETA notified the Commission that WVIA-TV had been operating at a reduced power since June 3, 2016 due to equipment problems. NPETA now notifies the Commission that WVIA-TV has resumed full power operation as of June 23, 2016.

NPETA is a noncommercial educational licensee and operates WVIA-TV on a noncommercial educational basis. The licensee is therefore exempt from FCC filing fee and regulatory fee requirements for WVIA-TV, pursuant to Sections 1.1116 and 1.1162 of the Commission’s rules.
