### **Five Second Campaign Texting & Driving**

Promotion geared toward making drivers (especially teen) aware of danger of texting while driving. Historically, many teens have been viewed as inexperienced drivers. Teens are also greatly known for their extensive use of their cellular telephone. Because cell phones can become very distracting, texting and driving is seen to be incredibly dangerous. The director of the PSA shows that although it may be an accident, becoming distracted behind the wheel of a car is likely to be extremely fatal.

### **Cigarette Litter Prevention**

In the past decade, cigarette smoking in America has decreased 28%, yet cigarette butts remain the most littered item in the U.S. and across the globe. Dropping cigarette butts and cigar tips to the ground, putting them in planters, and disposing of them in waterways is littering. The overall littering rate for cigarette butts is 65%, and tobacco products comprise 38% of all U.S. roadway litter. Much of this ends up in our waterways. The Ocean Conservancy's 212 International Coastal Cleanup showed cigarette butts as the most littered item, representing 32% of all items collected, and 2% of smoking-related debris was cigar tips. Why do smokers litter? 63% of cigarette butt littering is attributable to individual motivations. Mostly, it's lack of awareness about the environmental impact and insufficient ash receptacles. New ordinances are also moving more smokers outdoors or to designated areas, and over the past decade auto makers have phased out ash trays as a standard feature in new cars.

Here's why littering cigarette butts and cigar tips, an emerging concern, matters: it's unsightly, costly to clean up, and harmful to waterways and wildlife.
